Dear Minister,

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of the Republic of Singapore for Air Services between and beyond their Respective Territories, signed at Singapore on 12 January 1971<sup>(1)</sup>, and to recent discussions which have taken place concerning proposed amendments of the Schedule annexed thereto.

As a result of these discussions, it was agreed that the Schedule should be amended as follows:

- (a) the substitution of "points in Vietnam" for "Saigon" in column 2 of Route II of Section I
- (b) the addition after "Kuala Lumpur" of "points in East Malaysia" in column 2 of Route II of Section I
- (c) the addition after "Bali" of "Perth" in column 4 of Route II of Section I.

If the foregoing is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Singapore, I have the honour to propose that this Note and your reply to that effect shall constitute an Agreement between the two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on the date of your reply.
